General Information and Rules

- **Date:** Thursday, June 2, 2022
- **Time:** 10:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. on Friday, June 3rd. You must arrive by 11:30 p.m. at the latest! (The celebration officially ends at 5:30 a.m. but seniors can begin to leave starting at 5:00 a.m.) Once you have been admitted, you will not be permitted to leave before 5am unless your parent/guardian have notified Dawn and Kerry in advance, and come to school to escort you from the event. You'll be having so much fun, you won't want to leave!
- **Entertainment:** DJ, games, various entertainment options, photos & lots of surprises!
- **Prizes:** Drawings for gift certificates, electronic gifts, cash, dorm appliances & more throughout the night! Every student admitted to the party is automatically entered. You must be present to win!
- **Food and Beverages:** All night we will be serving a variety of food items- dinner, breakfast items, snacks, fruit cups, candy, popcorn, desserts, cold soft drinks, water, and more.
- **What to Bring:** Bring your yearbook and yourself (please put your name in your yearbook). We will provide the pens for your friends to sign. There will also be a basket in the girls' bathroom with girls' necessities. There is no need to bring money or any valuable jewelry which could get lost. If you need to bring medicine for any reason, the EMT on duty will hold it for you until needed. There will be photographers taking digital photos for you all evening.
- **Phones and keys will be checked in at the front desk for safekeeping if brought into the event.** Items like purses, hoodies, etc. should either be left at home, or left in your car.
- **Dress Code:** Cool, comfortable clothes! Shorts and t-shirts are a good idea. It gets very hot in the school!
- **Goody Bags:** These favor bags are labeled with your names on them. Use them throughout the night for photos, etc.!
